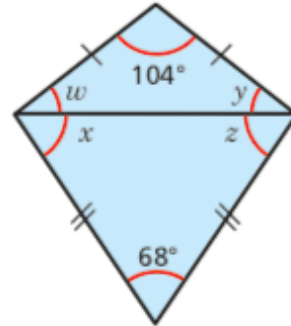

a) Work out the sizes of the unknown angles.

b) Work out $w + x$.

Answer

This is my suggestion to how they should be sorted. The actual order of the sentences might be different in your answer but you should have put the sentences under the correct sub-heading.

Canines

Humans have 4 canine teeth, one in each quarter of the mouth, on each side of the incisors. Canines are pointy. Canines are used for tearing and ripping food.

Incisors

Humans have 8 incisors altogether; 4 in the upper jaw and 4 in the lower jaw. Incisors are shovel-shaped. Incisors are used for biting and cutting food.

Molars

Humans have 8 molars, two in each quarter of the mouth. They are at the back of the mouth behind the premolars. Molars are large and flat for grinding food.
