Complete the calculations.

a)  $\frac{1}{5} + \frac{3}{4} = \frac{19}{20}$

c)  $\frac{1}{2} - \frac{1}{7} = \frac{5}{14}$

b)  $\frac{7}{8} - \frac{1}{3} = \frac{13}{24}$

d)  $\frac{11}{18} + \frac{7}{12} = 1\frac{7}{36}$

Complete the additions.

Give your answers as mixed numbers and as improper fractions.

a)  $\frac{4}{5} + \frac{5}{4} = \frac{41}{20} = 2\frac{1}{20}$

c)  $\frac{9}{8} + \frac{8}{9} = \frac{145}{72} = 2\frac{1}{72}$

b)  $\frac{2}{3} + \frac{3}{2} = \frac{13}{6} = 2\frac{1}{6}$

d)  $2\frac{4}{15} = \frac{34}{15} = \frac{5}{3} + \frac{3}{5}$
