



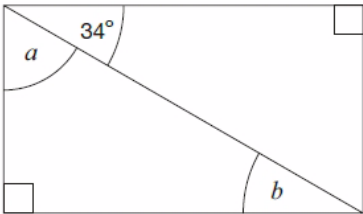

Do **not** measure the angles.

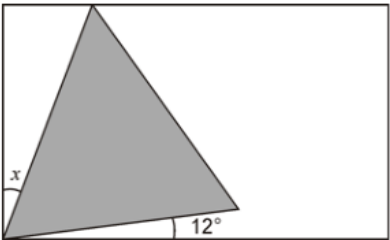
